#### **Schedule**

Friday afternoon/evening	Early arrivers can meet at the Fox & Roman or the Cross Keys

#### **Taxis**

Especially if you're sharing, it's often worth getting a taxi.

There's a taxi rank at the station. At busy times (like Friday mid-afternoon onwards), there can be quite a queue.

### Buses to and from Stableside and local pubs

All buses from the station leave from the stops opposite the station (turn right, and cross at the crossing — slightly different layout from last year) marked with the relevant routes. Bus stops are shown on the map as circles (in this case, purple). Bus stops have displays and also show numbers you can text for up-to-date ETAs.

You can get any of: 12, 13, 4, or the (usually) double-decker Coastliners (840, 843). All buses should have on-board announcements/displays for each stop.

There are three bus stops close together near Stableside and the local pubs. Slingsby Grove is the nearest to Stableside; St Edward's Church is also very near. The 12, 13, 840 and 843 stop at both of those on request. The 4 stops at the Marriott then turns right at the lights and stops round the corner in St Helen's Road.

When travelling back towards the station, get a bus at the stop by the Cross Keys.

### **Buses to and from Bishopthorpe**

There are two options — the 11 or the 21, marked red and yellow on the map (see also map overleaf). Both leave from the stops opposite the station. The 21 route is rather more circuitous, as you see. Saturday timetables (actual times vary) are:

If on the 11, get off at Acaster Lane End (after passing the church on your right, the bus swings right, then turns sharp left, and there's the bus stop).

If on the 21, get off opposite Bishopthorpe Library (bus turns left into the village from Sim Balk Lane).

If getting an **11 bus back towards York**, get it at the Bishopthorpe Library stop (on the same side of the road as The Marcia).

If getting a **21 bus back into York**, get it at the Bishopthorpe Library stop (across the road from The Marcia)

## Walking to Bishopthorpe from Stableside

It's about 2 miles door-to-door.

- 1 Turn right from Stableside into Tadcaster Road, then right again into Cherry Lane. With the Holiday Inn on your left, walk straight down to the end of Cherry Lane, through the car park and onto the racecourse.
- 2 Cross the racetrack and turn right onto the service road that runs inside the track. Follow the service road round to the south end of the racecourse (it's fine to cut across the grass instead of following the road, but it might be wet).
- 3 Cross back over the racetrack. There will be gaps in the railings, but you might have to duck under the top rail.



4 Turn left on the cycle/walking path. Follow the path up towards Middlethorpe Hall, on Bishopthorpe Road.



- 5 Cross Bishopthorpe Road at this point (there's pavement on only one side) and turn right. There's a bus stop (11 bus) if you've timed it right and want to ride the rest of the way.
- Otherwise, follow the road past the crematorium, to Bishopthorpe. Be aware the pavement is very narrow along the side of the Archbishop's Palace grounds. Cross the road opposite the church, by the Palace entrance, and walk round to the pub.
